VOTER INFORMATION

To Vote: You must be a U.S. citizen, will be 18 years old by the date of the election and registered to vote in the county of your residence. However, beginning with the 2020 primary election, if a voter turns 18 on or before the general election, the voter may vote in the primary election while still 17. Voters will be required to show ID before voting. . Voters without an ID may cast a provisional ballot or have another registered voter attest to their identification.

To Register: You may register to vote at the County Auditor's office, at your City Clerk's office, or by using a Voter Registration form available at those offices. Voter Registration forms are also available at DOT Driver's License Stations or at most human services agencies. You can register online at www.sos.iowa.gov.

Registration closes eleven (11) days before most elections, but ten (10) days before a general election. On election day, qualified voters may record, at their new polling place, a change of name, address or party. Contact the County Auditor or your City Clerk in advance of election day for additional information.

Your registration will remain valid unless: you have changed your name or address, or you have been convicted of a felony and have not had your rights restored by the Governor.

Eligible voters may register at the polling place for the precinct they live in. If you register to vote at the polls on Election Day you will be required to show proof of residence and proof of identity. Acceptable forms of ID include Iowa driver's license, Iowa non-operator's ID, passport, military ID, veteran's ID, tribal ID, or a state issued voter ID pin card. Voter ID cards must be signed before going to the polls. If your Iowa driver's license has an old address on it, you can use the license as proof of identity, and use one of the following as proof of residence if it contains your current address:

1. Residential lease
2. Utility bill
3. Paycheck
4. Property tax statement
5. Bank statement
6. Other Government document.

All documents must have your name, current address, and be dated within the last 45 days.

All forms of photo ID must be current, valid and contain an expiration date.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS-VOTING ABSENTEE:

You may vote in person at the Election Office at the County Courthouse within the twenty-nine (29) day period preceding an election or you may apply (no more than 120 days before an election) to the County Election Office using an official absentee application form for an absentee ballot which will be mailed to you. The absentee ballot request form must be received by the County Auditor, Bremer County Courthouse, Waverly, IA 50677 ten (10) days before a general election and eleven (11) days for all other elections.

Straight party voting is no longer available for voters.

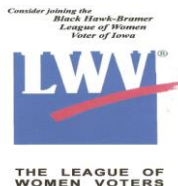
INFORMATION ABOUT LEAGUE
